 1. Won SCVAL, first time in 10 years to advance to CCS
 2. Lost 1st game in CCS vs Lincoln
 3. Moving up to De Anza division next year
 - ii. Varsity Girls Basketball (Naomi Nakano-Matsumoto)
 1. Team formed with 9 returning, 5 new players
 2. Moved up to De Anza division this year
 3. Scrimmage vs Silver Creek this Wednesday 11/16
 - iii. Varsity Softball (Scott Murray)
 1. Schedule released
 2. Conditioning in January/February
 - iv. Varsity Boys Water Polo (Sejal Patel)
 1. Ended season 8-8, tougher opponents in De Anza division this year
 2. Boys continued to improve as season progressed, ranked in the middle of the standings
